Subject: LATE LITTER REGISTRATION

Members are encouraged to register their puppies before they turn six (6) months.

Starting June 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021:

Registration of puppies over six (6) months to under one (1) year old will require:

- a) A fee of 500.00 pesos per month per puppy will apply. Month will be counted as 30 days.
- b) Other current penalties and fees apply.

Registration of puppies over one (1) year old will require:

- a) A valid reason as to why registration was late
- b) Will require board approval.
- c) A late registration penalty of 4,000.00 pesos per puppy will apply, if approved.
- d) All other current penalty and fees apply.

Registration of dog two (2) years old and above:

- a) A valid reason as to why registration was late
- b) Will require board approval
- c) If approved, will pay a penalty of 10,000.00 pesos per puppy.
- d) All other current fees and penalties apply.

Starting January 1, 2022:

Registration of puppies from six (6) months to under one (1) year old:


- a) A fee of 500.00 pesos per month per puppy will apply. Month will be counted as 30 days.
- b) Other current penalties and fees apply.

Registration of puppies from over (1) year old will require:

- a) A valid reason as to why registration was late.
- b) Will require board approval.
- c) Will incur a penalty of 10,000.00 pesos per puppy, plus all other late fees, microchip of all puppies to be registered.

****Please be informed that starting January 1, 2022, late registration of dogs two (2) years old and above will no longer be allowed.**
