

# LISTING OF UNREGISTERED DOGS

March 16, 2017

## 1. Breeds

1.1 All breeds that are recognized by any of the recognized Kennel Clubs of the Philippine Canine Club, Inc.

## 2. Procedures:

2.1 The owner must fill-up the **Application for Breed Listing Form**.

2.2 The PCCI will schedule the inspection of the dog for evaluation by a judge who is licensed for the breed. (*Inspection may be done at the PCCI or PCCI sanctioned dog shows*)

2.3 The Licensed Judge may approve or disapprove the application.

2.4 If the application is approved, the dog will be required to have either TATOO or MICROCHIP identification.

2.5 Listing fee is only Php500.00 plus VAT (*owner must apply to become a PCCI member if not yet a member*).

2.6 The dog will then be issued with a **PCCI LISTING CERTIFICATE**.

2.7 The 2<sup>nd</sup> Generation of the listed dog should be mated only to a PCCI registered dog.

## 3. Benefits/Advantages:

3.1 The Fourth Generation of the listed dog will get full registration and will be entered/recorded in the PCCI stud book.

3.2 Your unregistered dog may be used as foundation of your breeding program.

3.3 PCCI will be able to maintain a database of the listed breeds including:

3.3.1 Breeding Records

3.3.2 Stud Records

3.3.3 Transfer of Ownership History

3.3.4 Microchip Identification Numbers & Tattoo Numbers

3.4 PCCI can generate pedigree history of the listed breeds which is an essential data to develop and improve your breeding program.

3.5 Listed Dogs can participate in Performance events like Agility, Obedience Trials, Flyball and other non-traditional dog sport activities.
